On Saturday, July 30th, children from the visiting orphanage arrived, and wow, God was evident in some of their lives and in other's you could see His seeds we were planting or watering. The GOD made me special story was exactly what these kids needed to hear, and the tears on a few of the older kids faces were evidence of God's work in their Hearts. We also gave each one of these students, 54 total, a backpack with supplies, some clothing, a student bible and a blanket. We found out from the head ladv that none of these students had backpacks, and that this was a huge blessing to them. They were so excited to get them. We packed them up nicely in duffels to load onto the bus to take them back to their home. When the Bus arrived I was skeptical how everyone was going to fit. At most in America this bus would hold 16 passengers, but somehow 30 people and 5 XXL duffels made it on board. Where there is a will there is a way right? Beatrice, the head mom at Haven said, look there is plenty of room and they aren't even squished. I laughed so hard. They had at least one on each lap and some smaller kids 2 to a lap.

I could go down the list and tell you why God brought each person on this trip, but I would need several more pages. Still, I feel lead to share with you one more amazing outcome of this trip. God will make a way where there seems to be no way. Sunday after service at the local church, Kathy, myself, my niece Katie, and Elizabeth, one of the mom's, went to visit a lady in the community. This lady had head surgery four months ago and was still bleeding from the wound. Right before we started our trek I ran into Lucy the kitchen manager at Haven and she told me more about Margaret and how she had been taking her to her doctor appointments until the money had run out. I found out from her that a tumor was removed and they discovered later it was cancerous. I told you earlier about God putting together our team, right? Kathy is a retired nurse, and we all brought first aid kits and basic medical supplies knowing we were going off the map. Kathy was able to change the dressings, (the worst wound she had ever seen) and properly wrap it back up, letting the family know Margaret needed immediate medical attention. The family then told Kathy they had run out of funds a few months back and no longer had money for her care. (Kenya is not like America, you can't just show up at an ER, if they had one, and get care and get to leave. You can't leave unless you can pay, and the longer you stay the more you owe, so people just don't go, even if they are dying.) Another fun fact about Kathy is, she was worried about this trip, everyone telling her not to go, except me who told her, did God tell you not to go? Well

no, then He has a plan for you on this trip, and He decides when we die not the terrorists. I would rather die doing the work of God than any other way. And because of this worry she brought a bit of extra money with her in case we got stuck somewhere. God knew why she brought the extra money. She told the family she didn't have a lot of money, but she would give them the \$500 she had, and I told them I would give them \$50 for the transportation. See, God had a reason for Kathy going. Janice the founder of Haven on the Hill was headed to town that Tuesday and would take Margaret with her. With the money Kathy gave, the hospital would start the care on Margaret. The bill was around \$400 that day, and she was 3 months behind on what we would call insurance, she needed about \$100 to make it up, at which point they would pay the bulk of what was needed for the chemo. Because of this insurance, they would go ahead and start the chemo treatments as well. <u>Our God is amazing</u>. This family was trusting in God to deliver what they needed, and HE did. This story makes me realize again and again that each time we feel God's call we need to answer it. We never know what He has planned, but it is big and life changing and because of His love and infinite mercy lets us be a part of it. All we have to say is "Yes Lord". How many times do we miss out of the miracles and blessing of God by not answering His call? (Too many times to count) The truth is He can do it all without us, but He involves us so we can receive His Blessing. Our God is too good. There is so much more I could say about this trip. God used each member of our team in a different way, but the results are the same: <u>all the Glory and Praise go to God our King.</u>

I was able to travel to South Texas Children's Home in Pettus, Texas on August 26th and share school supplies with them and spend the day meeting much of the staff and leadership. It was a great day and we



laid the groundwork for partnering with them more in the future.

All together this year, we were able to provide children (in Kenya and Texas) with 275 uniforms, 350 backpacks, 850+ notebooks, 1,000+ exercise books, 1,700+ pens, 4,300+ pencils, 600 erasers, 600 pencil sharpeners and 400+ toothbrushes. This far surpassed anything I could have imagined one year ago when we began this journey.

We also plan to seek out similar opportunities in communities in Texas, around the United States, and in other international locales.
