

Mission Trip 2018.....Trusting God when things aren't going your way!!

She lives in one of the poorest homes we visit with our basket of blessings: food, soap, blankets, etc. Many of us can't imagine a house with mud sides and dirt floor, with the only room on the inside for a small table and sleeping on both sides. The bed area is raised off the ground by a contraption of sticks so the blankets don't get wet when it rains and the water comes in to coat the dirt floor and turn it into mud. When we arrived, we were invited to step into her house where there was literally no place to stand as large tea baskets filled the table and the small bend behind it. I know you are thinking, "but where to the store their clothes or anything for that matter?" The clothes they have on are most likely the only they own aside from a few others being washed and hung. The air was stale as we jumbled in on top of each other to give her and her family of 6 the much needed food. I remember the feeling of wanting to get out of the house, of almost feeling trapped inside. I couldn't wait to pray be that would mean we could get out of the house. Now as I reflect back, I wonder if this is how Teresia feels. If she feels trapped in her own home, by her own circumstances? I wonder as a

little girl, did she ever dream of something different for her life? I can tell you something I do know about her when we spoke, she asked for one thing and one thing only, a Bible. If you take a closer look at the head wrap you will notice what I failed to notice that day and the year before, on her head is the name "JESUS". So no matter how we might view her situation, she has a hope a lot of people know nothing about.
